

**AN ORDINANCE ADDING TITLE XI, CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.02  
AND CHAPTER 110, SECTION 110.35 (E) OF THE CODE OF  
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF GALENA, ILLINOIS**

**WHEREAS**, the Galena Code of Ordinances contains regulations related to peddlers and others who soliciting, peddle goods or services, or otherwise communicating with citizens of Galena, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the City Council to clarify that times of the day when such door-to-door solicitations or communications should occur to assure the health and welfare of the citizens of Galena without interfering with the rights of those individuals choosing to enter into such activities for whatever reason, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the further desire of the City Council to limit such door-to-door solicitations or communications to be within the hours of dawn to dusk on any given day.

**THEREFOR, BE IT ORDAINED** by the City Council of the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION I:** Chapter 110, entitled “GENERAL LICENSING, MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS REGULATIONS”, of the Galena Code of Ordinances shall be amended at Section 110.02 thereof, entitled “DEFINITIONS”, by adding the following language in the appropriate location in said section:

**DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITOR OR COMMUNICATOR.** Any person who is engaged in the contact with citizens for the purpose of religious, political, charitable, patriotic or philanthropic motivations or other similar solicitation or communication from door-to-door, house to house, place to place, or street to street.

**SECTION II:** Chapter 110, entitled “GENERAL LICENSING, MISCELLANEOUS BUSINESS REGULATIONS”, of the Galena Code of Ordinances shall be amended at Section 110.35 thereof, entitled “VENDORS AND ITINERANT MERCHANTS; PEDDLERS”, by adding the following language as subparagraph (E) thereof:

**(E) *Hourly limitations on Door-To-Door Peddlers, Solicitors or Communicators.*** It shall be unlawful for Peddlers or Door-to-Door Solicitors or Communicators as defined in this Title to peddle, solicit or communicate for commercial, business, religious, political, charitable, patriotic or philanthropic purposes door-to-door, house-to-house, place-to-place or street-to-street after sunset or before sunrise on any day.

**SECTION III:** All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.


