Dan Balocca, Felt Manor Guest House – had a set back with the Zoning Board last week on the text amendment. He is going before the City Council on Monday July 22, 2013 to accept Special Use Permit Application for Historic large properties in low density residential area. He is asking the City to provide the process the intent by adding a text amendment to the land use matrix to allow for such applications to the Zoning Board.

Consideration and possible action on GHPC letter to IDOT concerning façade. (No enclosure).

Pat Mc Carthy representing O'Connor & Brooks stated:

- That in a few years there will be major reconfiguration of Spring St. and it will affect his business, the front now will be the right side and the left side would be the front entrance.
- That he is requesting to continue the façade that is present on the now front to continue to the left side of the building which will become the new entrance.
- That he is requesting a letter from the GHPC Board to the State of Illinois stating the historic nature of this building at the entrance of the Historic District in the City of Galena.

1. State Historic Conferences:

Duff Stewart, Building Inspector shared information about the Illinois State Wide Preservation Conference June 28 in Evanston, IL. Daryl Watson presented thirty-three slide show, and it was well received, a unanimous vote that went very quickly. Now the seventy seven page packet is in the hands of Andrew Heckenkamp , who is IHPA Survey and National Register Coordinator. He will be sending this packet and several others to Washington DC in the next three to four weeks, in Washington DC it will take another six to eight weeks for approval.

Mike Jackson is still very determined that Galena becomes a National Landmark District. Jackson brought up another criteria for the world stage and that would be a "World Heritage Site" designation award.

2. Publications:

Craig Brown stated that there will be a National Historic Conference coming up in November that he will be attending.

Duff Stewart Building Official stated that he received information on the Senate's Approach to Tax reform, protecting the Historic Tax Credit, please call your Senator's and express your desire to support this.

HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE:

Craig Brown, Chairperson, stated that he is a long way down the line toward having the entire Historic District online, so every individual address in the Historic District will have their two surveys, there photographs, there old photo's if any, a narrative from the owner, so any tourist coming to town can come to Galena and look it up.
