

City of Galena Street Vacation Plan

Legend



1. An ordinance was adopted on 7 June 1904 vacating that portion of Warren Street between Prospect Street and Locust Street. Commencing at the southwest corner of lot 6 block 27 in the original City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, Illinois; thence north 55 degrees 43 minutes 25 seconds east, along the south line of said lot 6, a distance of 89.94 feet; thence south 90 degrees 46 minutes 35 seconds east 23.68 feet; thence south 55 degrees 43 minutes 25 seconds west, parallel with the south line of said lot 6, a distance of 93.40 feet; thence north 00 degrees 09 minutes 00 seconds east, 25.46 feet to the point of the beginning, said the containing 1924 square feet, more or less, all situated in the City of Galena, on the west side of the Galena River, Jo Daviess County, Illinois. It is the intent to describe a uniform strip of land being 21 feet in width and bounded by the east and west lot lines of the Kurdt property extended southerly to form the property of Dodge Street.
2. An ordinance was adopted on 6 November 1906 vacating that portion of Murf Street behind and between Warren Street and Birch Street on the west side of the Galena River.
3. On July 2 of 1907, an ordinance was adopted that vacated that portion of Wann Street extending from Field Street to Thomas Street on the west side of the Galena River.
4. On 2 March 1921 that portion of Lafayette Street in East Galena being 100 feet easterly from Third Street was vacated.
5. On 4 May 1920, an ordinance was adopted which vacated a portion of Washington Street between Main Street and bench Street. The part discontinued along and adjacent to the northerly line of Washington Street fronting seven feet on Main Street and extending westerly to Bench Street and fronting seven feet on Bench Street.
6. An ordinance adopted on 7 February 1928 vacating an alley 22 feet wide, running 128 feet south from Mississippi Street in Gea's second addition is hereby vacated.
7. An ordinance was adopted on 6 January 1931, which widened a portion of Spring Street, located between Bench and Water streets, otherwise designated as Main Street.
8. On 7 November 1933, an ordinance was adopted vacating parts of street and alleys in the James G. Soular's first addition to the city. The streets vacated are as follows: Elk Street from the intersection of Elk Street and East Hickory Street to the intersection of Elk Street and East Tyler Street and also the alley running through blocks 5 and 9 in James G. Soular's first addition to the City of Galena.
9. On 4 September 1934, an ordinance was adopted vacating an alley running from Hickory Street to Tyler Street between block 5 and 8 in the City of Galena.
10. On 7 April 1935, an ordinance was adopted vacating that portion of Fourth Street located on the east side of the Galena River from the intersection of Lafayette Street to the intersection of Southlillier Street.
11. On 7 July 1931, an ordinance was adopted accepting a lot from Elizabeth Thompson for use as a park area the lot is described as lot 4 in block 63 from 202 feet on Hill Street and running back 155 feet more or less. This parcel offered for sale on 7 August 1945.
12. No longer applicable. On 7 April 1936, an ordinance was adopted vacating part of streets and alleys in Bridgeport's addition to the City of Galena. That portion of College Street west of Pine Street, all alleys in said original block 13, in said Bridgeport's addition; Clay Street north and west of Elm Street; Clinton Street west of Elm Street; Fulton Street north and west of Elm Street; Argyle Street north of Bridge Street; Hill Street north of Bridge Street; Elm Street north of Clay Street; and any and all alleys that be located in said above block.
13. On 13 August 1945, an ordinance was adopted vacating that part of the streets and alleys in the City of Galena called and known as follows: Hickory Street between Elm Street and Pine Street.
14. On 5 March 1946, another vacation occurred on the ground or streets as follows: the portion of Galena Avenue beginning at the northwest corner of lot 1 in block 8 in H.H. Gear's second addition to the City of Galena, thence southerly 147 feet to the southwest corner of lot 3 in said block 8, thence westerly 50 feet, thence northerly parallel with the westerly boundaries of lot 1, 2, and 3 in said block 8 a distance of 147 feet, thence easterly to the point of beginning, all situated on the west side of the Galena River.
15. On 2 July 1946, an ordinance was adopted vacating the remainder of Galena Avenue and a certain alley described as follows: that portion of Galena Avenue beginning at the southwest corner of lot 3, in block 8, in H.H. Gear's second addition to the City of Galena, thence southerly to the intersection of Galena and Burzee Street in the City of Galena on the west side of the Galena River, and following alley as described as follows: the 22 feet alley beginning at the northeast corner of lot 1 in block 9 in H.H. Gear's second addition to the City of Galena and running southerly to the intersection of Burzee Street on the City of Galena on the west side of the Galena River.
16. In April of 1947, an ordinance was adopted vacating a part of Washington Street between Main Street and Bench Street. This ordinance starts by repealing the ordinance that was adopted on the fourth day of May 1920. This ordinance then goes on and states that the following portion is vacated. That portion of the Galena River is vacated and is described as follows: a strip of ground of the uniform width of 5 feet along and adjacent to the northerly line of said Washington Street fronting 5 feet on Main Street and extending westerly to Bench Street and fronting 5 feet on said Bench Street.
17. On 7 October 1947, an ordinance was adopted vacating a remaining part of Galena Avenue from Burzee Street from the intersection of Water Street as originally platted of the intersection of Galena Avenue, Iowa Street from the intersection of Water Street as originally platted to the intersection at Galena Avenue and the alley connecting Mississippi Street with Iowa Street and an alley connecting Iowa Street between Burzee Street all on the west side of the Lena River.
18. On 23 March 1950, an ordinance was adopted that vacated Harris Street in the City of Galena. Harris Street is entirely located in Harris's addition to the City on the west side of the Galena River. On 4 April 1950, an ordinance was adopted continued from 18: which evidently gave a portion of some land located near Harris Street and Ride Street to the Jo Daviess County Housing Authority.
19. On 27 March 1951, an ordinance was adopted vacating several street and alleys in H.H. Gear's first and second addition to the city. They are described as follows: Mississippi Street from the east line of Galena Avenue west to the west line of Water Street as relocated and established by city ordinance dated 25 September 1893 and altered plat of H.H. Gear's second addition dated 23 September 1893. Also, Iowa Street from the west line of Water Street as originally located to the west line of Water Street as now located by the above mentioned ordinance and plat. Also, Burzee Street from the west line of Water Street as originally located to the west line of Water Street as now located by the above mentioned ordinance and plat. Also, the east and west alley in block 9 of Gear's second addition to Galena from the east line of vacated Galena Street east to the west line of vacated north and south alley in said block 9 between Iowa and Burzee Streets. Also, the alley in block 1 of Gear's first addition to Galena from the north line of Mississippi Street to the south line of vacated South Street.
20. On 26 June 1951, that portion of west Water Street was vacated commencing at the northeast corner of lot 84 a distance of 16 feet, 2 inches and thence running southerly parallel with the easterly line of lots 81, 82, 83, and 84 at a distance of 158 feet, 3 inches thence westerly on a line with the south line of lot 81 a distance of 4 feet, 4 inches, thence northerly on the easterly line of lots 81, 82, 83, and 84 to the place of beginning.
21. On 7 November 1952, an ordinance was adopted vacating a portion of Hill Street at and near its intersection with Water Street commencing at a point on the southerly side of Hill Street at the intersection of the southerly side of Hill Street with the westerly side of Water Street, thence in a northerly direction along the southerly line of Hill Street 140 feet to the point, thence a 90 33/64 angle from the last corner southerly parallel southerly side of Hill Street 140 feet to a point, thence at a 90 33/64 angle from the last course 8 feet to the point of beginning.
22. On 28 May 1957, an ordinance was adopted vacating a portion of Bridge Street described as the part of Bridge Street north of block 6 and westerly of an extension of the east boundary of block 6, North of Galena addition to the City of Galena.
23. On 8 March 1960, the city vacated a part of Hill Street from Elk Street to Franklin Street and a portion of a 20 foot alley in block 10 of the J.D. Soular's second addition for the convenience of the abutting property owners.
24. On 24 August 1966, an alley was vacated in block 10 in James G. Soular's addition to the city described as the alley abutting the rear of the lots fronting on Franklin Street and the rear of the lots fronting Elk Street on block 10 of James G. Soular's addition to the City of Galena and is vacated; reserving, however, an easement for utility purposes.
25. At their regular council meeting of 28 October 1974, the council approved that Elm Street be vacated between Fulton and Bridge streets in return for lots 1 and 2 owner by the John Dayton estate and adjacent to Fulton and Elm streets and the same be conveyed to the executor of the estate of John Dayton with legal costs to be assumed by the estate.
26. An ordinance passed 28 July 1975, vacating a 25 foot strip in the Alexander Young addition to the City of Galena beginning at the intersection of Oak Street and running northerly adjoining lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 9, and 11 in block 2 of Alexander Young's addition to the City of Galena. The new survey plat showing the new routing of McBeams's street was vacated at this meeting also.
27. An ordinance passed 19 April 1976 vacating that portion of West Street lying between Franklin Street on the north and Elk Street on the south in the City of Galena, County of Jo Daviess and State of Illinois.
28. An ordinance passed on 19 April 1976 vacating that portion of Alexander Street running from oak Street between block 4 and block A and between lot 1 and lot 23 in block 5 in the north Galena addition to the City of Galena on the west side of the Galena River in the County of Jo Daviess, State of Illinois.
29. An ordinance passed 11 October 1976 vacating that portion of Green Street lying between West Street and Division Street on the west side of the Galena River in the City of Galena, County of Jo Daviess, State of Illinois.
30. An ordinance passed 11 October 1976 vacating that portion of Oak Street being 50 feet in width and 153 feet in depth which lies between lot 1 in block 9 and lot 15 in block 8 all in Young's addition to the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, Illinois.
31. An ordinance passed 25 June 1979 vacating the alley located in block D, North Galena Subdivision, lying west of the Galena River, bordering on Oak Street and running approximately parallel to Franklin and Campbell streets and being part of the NE 25-64 section 13, township 28.
32. An ordinance passed 25 June 1979 vacating that portion of Hill Street which intersects with Water Street, an exact description of which is shown on the survey which is attached to the ordinance.
33. An ordinance passed 25 June 1979 vacating that portion of Washington Street lying between Commerce and Water Streets.
34. An ordinance passed 25 June 1979 vacating that portion of Oak Avenue which lies between lots 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, and 12 in sublot 7 of Armbrast's subdivision of the City of Galena, IL.
35. An ordinance passed 14 January of 1980 vacating that portion of Van Buren Street located between Third and Southlillier Streets on the east side of the Galena River in the City of Galena and is shown on the plat of the same dated continued from 35; February 9, 1848 and recorded April 1, 1948 in Book 1 of deeds, at page 444 in the recorder's office of Jo Daviess County, IL.
36. An ordinance was passed 14 January 1980 vacating that portion of Fourth Street located between Southlillier and Jackson streets on the east side of the Galena River in the City of Galena and is shown on the plat of the same dated February 9, 1848 and recorded April 1, 1848 in Book 1 of deeds, at page 444 in the recorder's office of Jo Daviess County, IL.
37. An ordinance was passed 12 November 1979, vacating a part of the intersection of Elk and Prospect streets, beginning at the southeast corner of said intersection.
38. An ordinance passed 23 March 1981 vacating: Parcel 1: All that portion of Warren Street lying between the easterly line of High Street and the westerly line of Locust Street extended southerly to its intersection with the northerly line of lot 1 in block 9 in the original town of Galena. Parcel 2: The easterly 10 feet of Locust Street lying adjacent to the south 20 feet of lot 3 and lot 4 and 5 in Bennett's and Hempstead's alteration of block 7. Parcel 3: All that portion of Warren Street lying westerly of a line 6 feet east of the westerly line of Prospect Street and running westerly to the easterly line of Locust Street extended southerly to its intersection with the northerly line of lot 2 in block 9 in the original town of Galena. Parcel 4: The westerly 6 feet of Prospect Street lying adjacent to the south 20 feet of lots 2, 4, and 6 in block 9. Parcel 5: The westerly 6 feet of Prospect Street lying adjacent to the south 20 feet of lots 3, 4, and 5 in Bennett's and Hempstead's alteration of block 7.
39. An ordinance passed on 25 July 1983: beginning at a point on the easterly line of Liberty Street which point is 15 0' southerly from the southerly line of Washington Street in said City of Galena thence southerly 20 0' at a right angle along said easterly line of Liberty Street thence westerly 12 5' at an angle of 90 33/64 36' as measured counter clockwise from the point of beginning; thence easterly 12 5' to the point of beginning, said portion of Liberty Street contains 367 square feet more or less.
40. An ordinance adopted 10 October 1983 vacating beginning at the southwesterly corner of lot 6 of Robert J. Fox's re-survey of block 6 North Galena subdivision, west side of the Galena River, in the City of Galena as it appears and is recorded in plat book 7, page 50 in the Office of the Jo Daviess County recorder; thence southerly to lot 3 of block 12 of J.W. Campbell's addition for use as part of Elm Street.
41. An ordinance adopted 22 September 1986 vacating a 20 foot square portion of Monroe Street between Fourth and Fifth Streets on the east side of the Galena River.
42. An ordinance adopted passed 14 December 1987 vacating a portion of Elm Street and a portion of Bridge Street in exchange for a portion of lot 3 of block 12 of J.W. Campbell's addition for use as part of Elm Street.
43. An ordinance passed 14 December 1987, vacating a portion of the Soular Street north of Irvine Street as a uniform strip beginning at the north line of Irvine Street 25 feet wide and 230.21 feet long.
44. An ordinance passed 14 December 1987 vacating a portion of city right of way on Main Street 1 8 feet wide and 34 10' long in front of lot 4 of block 6 between Main, Water, and Warren streets.
45. An ordinance passed on April 25, 1988 vacating that portion of Monroe Street which lies between Fourth Street and Fifth Street in the City of Galena, east side of the Galena River.
46. An ordinance passed on May 19, 1988 vacating those portions of Summer, Cedar, Newhall and Klockow streets lying west of Gear Street abutting on block 3 and block 4 in Newhall's addition to the City of Galena according to the recorded plat of said addition.
47. An ordinance passed on March 13, 1989 vacating that portion of Clay Street being 60 feet in width and 850 feet in length, which lies northerly of blocks 11 and 12 in Bridgeport or William Campbell's addition and southwesterly of lots 1 and 2 in block 143 in Bridgeport or William Campbell's addition and southwesterly of J.W. Campbell's subdivision being all of City street running from the southwesterly to the northerly westerly line of Pine Street all located in the City of Galena, west side of the Galena River.
48. Two ordinances passed on June 22, 1992 vacating a portion of north Dodge Street commencing at the southeast corner of lot 68 between Gratiot and Harrison Streets, in the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, IL.
49. An ordinance passed July 27, 1992 vacating a portion of Soular Street lying north of Kelly Lane extended west and south the north line of block 2 of J & M subdivision.
50. An ordinance passed December 14, 1992, vacating a portion of Hill Street lying on west line of lots 6, 7, and 8 in block 11, James G. Soular's second addition.
51. An ordinance passed September 27, 1993 vacating a portion of Powder Hill Road, Fourth Street, and Fifth Street, abutting Delos Welg, George J. Folks, Sr., George Folks, Jr., and Jeanie Folks (parcel of land in northwest quarter of section 21, township 28N, range 1 east of fourth principal meridian), (parcel of continued from 51; land located in northwest quarter of section 21, township 28 north, range 1 east of fourth principal meridian).
52. An ordinance passed March 28, 1994 vacating a portion of Hickory Street (Mary and Richard Auman and Weinen Brothers, Inc, 3 parcels 0-84-1, Lot 1, Block 8 of James D. Soular's addition, 5,588 SQ. FT., more or less. 2. Lot 1, Block 6 of James D. Soular's addition, 2,833 SQ. FT., more or less. 3. Lot 6, Block 8 of James D. Soular's addition, 2,785 SQ. FT., more or less.
53. An ordinance passed May 23, 1994 vacating a portion of Warren Street located between blocks 17 and 18, beginning at the south corner of said block 18 at corner of Dodge Street and Warren Street, 2,250 SQ. FT.
54. An ordinance passed August 1994 vacating a portion of Division Street and (8 parcels) (Wayne L. Feltzer, Cynthia Phillips, Rita A. Arger, Jeffrey and Susan Miller and Jean Groves) 1. Lot 1 and lot 5, Quality Hill subdivision, 5,470 SQ. FT. 2. Lot 2, block 63, Field and Townsend's addition, 3,010 SQ. FT. 4. Lot 9, Quality Hill subdivision, 2,200 SQ. FT. 5. Lot 5, Quality Hill subdivision, 9,980 SQ. FT.
55. An ordinance passed on 26 October 1996, providing for the vacation of apportion of Barry Street lying between Ridge Street and Hill Street in the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, IL. The northerly one-half of that portion of Barry Street located between Ridge Street and Hill Street on Friel and Townsend's addition to the City of Galena, on the west side of the Galena River.
56. An ordinance passed 26 October 1996, providing for the vacation of apportion of Barry Street lying between Ridge Street and Hill Street on the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, IL. The southerly one-half of that portion of Barry Street located between Ridge Street and Hill Street in Field and Townsend's addition to the City of Galena, on the west side of the Galena River, in West Galena Township, Jo Daviess County, IL.
57. Ordinance #0-02-02. An ordinance passed on 24 January 2000, providing for the vacation of a portion of Bluff Street lying between Jo Daviess Street and West Street in the City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, IL. A portion of Bluff Street lying between Jo Daviess Street and West Street and located in the City of Galena, situated on the west side of the Galena River, in West Galena Township, Jo Daviess County, IL.
58. That part of West Street from Dewey Avenue to the midpoint of Harrison Street and located in the City of Galena, situated on the west side of the Galena River, in West Galena Township, Jo Daviess County, IL. The area subject to the vacation is adjacent to lot 9 of block 9 in Young's addition of West Galena Township, City of Galena, Jo Daviess County, IL and lot 75 in the original town of Galena, West Galena Township, Jo Daviess County, IL.
