Swimming Lessons

LESSON INFORMATION

- ✓ Registration will be at Galena City Hall until May 24. Beginning May 26, registration will be conducted at the Alice T. Virtue Memorial Pool during regular operating hours.
- ✓ Rain days are not rescheduled. Lessons are only cancelled if severe weather is occurring or imminent. Wondering if lessons will be held? Call the pool @ 815-777-0802.
- ✓ Refunds will be given for cancellations up to seven days before the first scheduled lesson.
- ✓ Classes are subject to change depending on the number of registrations.
- ✓ Parents and guardians are asked to bring children into the pool area five minutes prior to lessons and gather in the concessions courtyard. Once students have been released to instructors, guardians are asked to leave the pool area to avoid distraction. You may watch from the outside of the fenced area in our bleachers or enjoy the park while your student is in lessons.

PARENT-CHILD AQUATICS (July 15-18, 2019, 6-7 pm)

- ✓ At least six infants (6 months to 2 years of age) must be registered for the session to proceed. Refunds will be given if the session is cancelled for too few participants.
- ✓ Children must be accompanied in the water by a parent or guardian.

ADULTS (2019 dates to be announced)

- ✓ We may conduct adult classes during normal swimming lessons morning hours or schedule an evening class based on the interest of the students.
- ✓ At least five adults must be registered for the session to proceed. Refunds will be given if the session is cancelled for too few participants.

AGES 3-17 (Four Sessions, each 10 days in length, excluding July 4 holiday)

- ✓ Lessons are not cancelled due to rain or cold temperatures. That time may be used for safety presentations conducted in the bath house. If you feel your child will not tolerate lessons on a cold day we understand if you choose to keep them home.
- ✓ Please register your child for the class they should be in based on previous lessons or ask the lessons coordinator for assistance. On the first day of lessons and throughout the lesson period, the instructor will be testing skill levels to make sure each student is in the appropriate class. Students may be moved to an appropriate level to best suit their skills based on teacher assessment.
- ✓ **FUN NIGHT:** *Fun Night is the last Friday night of each session, from 7 – 9 PM.*

All immediate family members are invited to attend Fun Night, which provides an opportunity for children to demonstrate their acquired swimming skills. Children are permitted to bring inflatable devices into the pool during Fun Night. Passes for fun night will be distributed during lessons.

LESSON POLICY

- ✓ Lesson participants are allowed in the pool area five minutes prior to the scheduled start of lessons. For youth lessons, parents may accompany their children through the dressing room and stay until the child is accepted by the instructor at the designated area. Parents are asked to exit the pool area prior to the beginning of class to minimize distraction to the participants and the risk of injury to those not enrolled in lessons. Exceptions are made for children with physical and mental disabilities. The City of Galena is not responsible for those remaining in the pool area that are not participating or assigned to a class. Lessons will be provided regardless of weather. In the case of cool or inclement weather, we will have an in-service safety day. Parental discretion may be used regarding attendance. There are no make-up lessons. The City of Galena reserves the right to modify these policies as deemed necessary.
