Hi John,

Joe forwarded your request for information to me, as noted below. Attached please find our position paper on the deer population control program and our data summary of the program, from 1991 through the present.

Regarding the helicopter, I called the Helo service that we've been using the last few years to discuss this further. Our flight takes a good portion of the day, usually from about 9 am until 3 pm, including a trip to Dubuque to refuel. However, the pilot said that it would save ferrying fees for the pilot to stay in Dubuque overnight and pay to store the helicopter in the hangar there for the night. He estimated that at a couple hundred dollars plus the cost of hotel. The cost in 2013 was \$435 per flight hour, including the ferrying time, not just the time above our project. The helicopters fly in from Chicago, so I think they ferrying time is 1-1.5 hours, one-way. Our total invoice for this year's flight was \$3250. So, it takes about 5-5.5 hours to fly the 10.625 square miles of The Territory.

Please let me know if you have any other questions or if there is additional information I can provide. For instance, we completed a comprehensive program review in 2012 and have a lot of information from that process, if you think that will be useful.
