Dear Resident,

The City of Galena will be conducting a deer management archery hunt in your area during the 2018-19 deer hunting season. The season begins October 1, 2018 and ends January 20, 2019. You are being notified because your property is within 300 feet of the perimeter of the hunting site.

A map of the nearby hunting site and its boundary is enclosed. The hunting area is shaded orange with a green border. Hunting is *not* permitted inside of any of the black circles on the map. The black circles represent a 300-foot perimeter around occupied structures. State law does not permit hunting within 300 feet of an occupied structure without consent of the owner or tenant.

This is an archery hunt with bow and arrow only. An orange notification sign will be posted along any street adjoining the hunting site when hunting is in progress. The hunter(s) assigned to the site will select the dates and times to hunt. Each hunter must notify the Galena Police Department when entering a hunting site. Hunting may occur any day of the week from ½ hour before sunrise to ½ hour after sunset.

Archery hunters in the deer management program have successfully completed a bow and arrow shooting proficiency test. Each hunter also possesses a State of Illinois hunting license and permit.

Hunting within the city is planned due to the large number of deer, the damage caused by the deer, and the number of vehicle accidents involving deer. Our goal is to thin the herd to reduce property damage and accidents involving deer.
