



Galena ELECTRONICS RECYCLING

What: The City of Galena offers recycling for residential electronics as a lawful and environmentally-friendly manner of disposal.

Where: Electronics may be dropped at Galena City Hall parking lot, 101 Green Street, during monthly collection days.

When: Drop off your electronics the last Friday of each month (dates change in April, October, November and December) from 8 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. TVs and computer monitors are accepted at the same time for \$25 per unit.

Beginning January 1, 2012, the State of Illinois prohibited the deposit of electronics in landfills. The City's waste hauler, Montgomery Trucking, does not pick up any electronics left curbside with the exception of those items classified as white goods (refrigerators, ovens, etc.) when prior arrangement has been made. To meet the demand for electronics disposal, the City of Galena has partnered with T&T Recycling in East Dubuque. T&T is registered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency as a Residential E-Waster Recycler.

When an item is dropped off at the Galena collection site, the item becomes the property of T&T. Once an item is dropped off, the item cannot be reclaimed by the original owner. The City of Galena is not responsible for items after they have been dropped off.
